Individual paper development mentoring sessions: topic and contents for these sessions were defined by the participating faculty. In essence, each faculty member shared a work-in-progress manuscript with Prof. Lund Dean and together they worked on improving the manuscript so it could be submitted to an international journal.

For example, I worked on two manuscripts with Prof. Lund Dean: Towards "strong" multimodality: how graphic novel can help us rethink modes (currently in review for *Journal of Management Inquiry*) // Taken-for-granted no more: How multimodal syllabi can improve student engagement (target journal *Higher Education*)

Prof. Lund Dean's seminars and individual meetings have helped our faculty in two ways. First, develop our teaching competencies. Second, help us prepare manuscripts to be submitted to international academic journals. Both activities are extremely crucial given that College of Business is currently in the final stretch in the AACSB accreditation

process. What is more, given that we are currently exploring establishing a student exchange agreement between our institutions, funding Prof. Lund Dean's 1-month stay with us has been extremely beneficial. During AY2023-2024, I am expecting 4-5 manuscripts to be submitted to journals, thanks to Prof. Lund Dean's invaluable contributions and mentoring. Similarly, our faculty is currently in the process of developing their courses based on Prof. Lund Dean's seminars. What is more, Prof. Lund Dean has had meetings with our senior faculty and the focus of those meetings has been on establishing a more long-term relationship not only between Prof. Lund Dean and College of Business but also between Prof. Lund Dean's home institution and College of Business.
